- Parent educators hold focus groups with project parents and project children in each of the project schools.
- Holding mother-girl counseling sessions in each of the project schools.
- Model families inducted and supported in project school communities.
- Father-girl children reading sessions held in each of the project schools.
- Women's pressure groups supported to conduct home visits and develop policy briefs.
- Short films on parental involvement in children's learning produced and disseminated.
- Girls reading sessions held in a selected number of project communities, with reading materials produced in 5 local languages.
- Teachers and parent educators weekly classes and co-teaching sessions held in project communities.
- Support PLE examination process.
